Chris added: "This workshop provides a wonderful opportunity for young people to play in an ensemble and to experience the excitement of an orchestral concert." The 2-day workshop will be held at the Lion Walk United Reformed Church on

the Monday and Tuesday of half term – February 21st and 22nd, with a concert at 7.30 on the Tuesday evening for everyone's family and friends to see and hear what their youngsters have been up to.
